Due to Friday night Registrations and Safety Bag checks taking so long we will not be having any briefings on Friday night. Briefings will be emailed out and I will give the briefing before each run. If you have any questions please call or email me before. There will be a talk from some of our sponsors, a Question & Answer segment and also a chance for people to talk about their experiences in running and to advertise your run. This will be done during dinner after registration is closed.

AURA, Australian Long Course Trail Championship, 100 km will be part of our event and we are so proud of all the volunteers, sponsors, departments and especially the committee for putting in so much effort in the Hume & Hovell Ultra.

100 KM NEWS – CUT OFF TIME EXTENDED TO 24 HOURS - FINISH AT HENRY ANGEL. We had some requests from runners last year and meeting with the committee we could not see any reason not to extend the finish time.

T SHIRT ORDERS MUST BE IN BY FRIDAY 20 TH SEPTEMBER TO ALLOW THEM TIME TO BE MADE.  
A change of colour from black to Dark Heather, blue tone, we hope you will like them.

HUME & HOVELL BUFFS will be available for purchase on Friday, Saturday & Sunday. \$15.00 each.

CHANGES AT THE BIG BLUE ARCH: We want to get all runners off the road at Henry Angel so all runners will go through the arch even if you are not finishing, (like the 50 km runners). There will be taped chutes to assist runners through on the weekend. Electronic mats will now be at Mannus, Mt Garland and Henry Angel.

Mannus Lake boardwalk repairs are under way and should be completed by October, this will leave only 3 kms on road for the 100 milers and the 22 km runners. After 3 kms, these runners will go onto the boardwalk to the Mannus Check Point, then back onto the road for 1 km before turning left up into the hills. The 100 km and 50 km runners will only have 1 km of dirt road.

100 mile runners will again be able to use Safety Runners from the 111 km or second passing of The Pines Check Point. The Safety Runner must register (no cost) and carry the same mandatory gear as yourself.

Due to the remoteness of the area there is very limited mobile coverage. We have the NSW Rural Fire Service, Riverina Highlands and Wagga Amateur Radio covering the check points.

Smart Trackers for the 100 milers will be used again this year. Each miler participant will be allocated a SPOT tracker just before the start of the event. A link to the tracking web page will be put on our website and Facebook page the week before we start – you can share the link with family, friends and interested miler dot watchers.
